

The Constable Leo "Tyler" Francis Memorial Award

This award was established by the Crime Prevention Association of New Brunswick in honour and memory of the late Constable Tyler Francis, an RCMP officer who demonstrated both a high standard of dedication towards crime prevention.

This award is presented to police officers and peace officers who have been involved in crime prevention initiatives in their community for at least five years and have demonstrated significant personal and professional commitment in the function of these duties.

Nominations must:

- describe the contributions the nominee has made to crime prevention.
- include copies of newspaper articles if available
- any further information the committee should have in making their decision.

Nomination forms and supporting documentation must be received by September 30.
